You can now use our new interactive Knowledge Map on Thomson Reuters Practical Law™ to explore related content and topics.

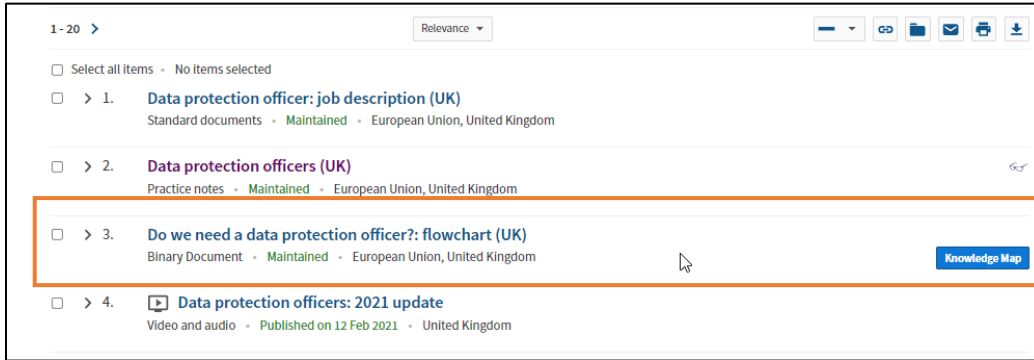
### Accessing the Knowledge Map

There are various ways to access a Knowledge Map for a document.

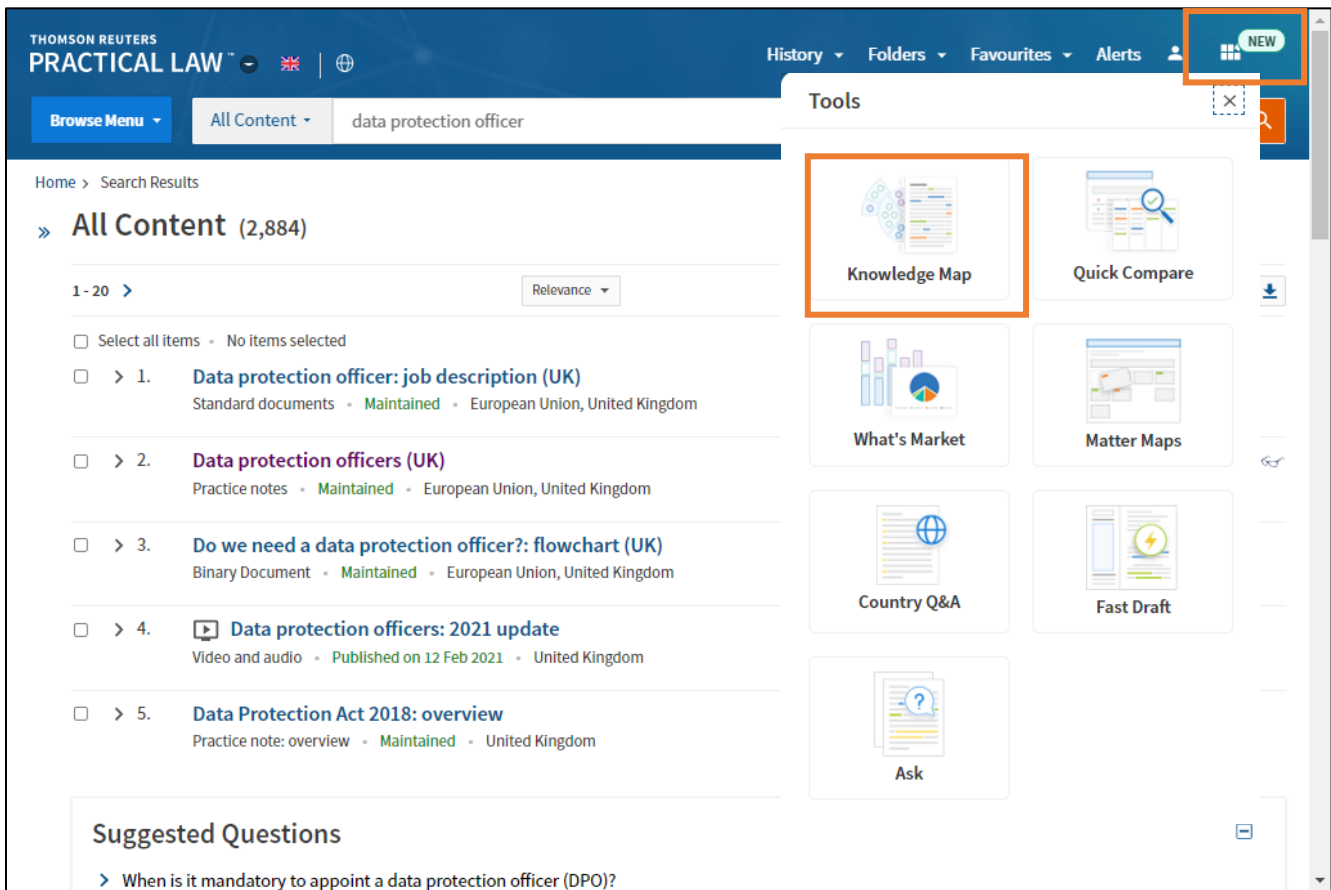
When viewing a document, click the Explore related content button at the top of the screen and then click Explore the Map!

### Using the Knowledge Map


You can move around the map and zoom in and out. Clicking on bubble will preview that document on the right and show the related content for that document in an outer ring.
